

Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade – Construction of a pedestrian island on Frenchs Forest Road East from Monday 16 September

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area

Roads and Maritime Services is installing a pedestrian refuge on **Frenchs Forest Road East** as part of the Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade project.

To complete this work, we will establish a work area on Frenchs Forest Road East between the Skyline Shops and the entrance to KFC from Monday 16 September to Saturday 16 November, weather permitting.

Due to the high volume of traffic and pedestrians in the area and to minimise interruption we will work from **7pm** to **5am** on our usual construction nights. Further information about specific night work activities will be distributed as required.

During the work, all traffic movements will be available. Access to **KFC** and the **Skyline Shops** will not be affected.

Traffic management will be onsite to assist motorists and pedestrians through these temporary conditions.

What will the work involve?

The work involves:

- demolishing existing kerb
- asphalting and line marking
- constructing a pedestrian island and pram ramps.

How will the work affect you?

During this time delays may take place in the area including along Frenchs Forest Road East and Allambie Road.

Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead, follow the directions of signage and keep to speed limits while this traffic arrangement is in place.

The work will involve the use of machinery which may generate some noise. We will use noise shields to reduce noise where appropriate and ensure equipment and vehicles are turned off when not in use.
