

Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade project – Traffic changes at the intersection of Warringah Road and Forest Way from Saturday 12 January


The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area.

Roads and Maritime Services is building a new bridge at Forest Way to go over the future Warringah Road underpass.

To allow us to safely progress this work, we need to make major changes to the way motorists travel through the Warringah Road and Forest Way intersection. The changes include:

- Removing the separated merge lane for motorists turning right out of Forest Way to Warringah Road citybound. Right turning vehicles will now travel through the intersection instead of on the separated merge lane.
- Introducing a red light for Warringah Road citybound on approach to the Forest Way intersection, to allow vehicles to turn right safely out of Forest Way towards Chatswood and the city.

How will the traffic changes affect you?

These traffic changes are needed to ensure the safety of workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians while we carry out this important work to upgrade the road.

Additional congestion and delays are expected in the area, particularly during AM and PM peak traffic periods. This includes along Warringah Road, Forest Way and Wakehurst Parkway as well as other roads in the area.

We are implementing this change during a time of the year with lower traffic volumes, to allow motorists to adjust to the new arrangements.

Please take extra care and be prepared to stop when approaching the intersection of Warringah Road and Forest Way.

These traffic changes will be implemented from **7pm Saturday 12 January** to **8am Sunday 13 January**, weather permitting and will be in place until the completion of the project. During this work, the following activities will take place:

- turning off traffic lights
- rearranging the intersection
- line marking
- turning on traffic lights.

Police will be onsite to control traffic while the traffic lights are turned off. Please use caution when travelling through the intersection and follow the directions of police and traffic controllers.

Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead, allow extra time and travel outside the peaks where possible.

Check livetraffic.com before you drive for the latest information on traffic conditions. You can also download a real-time road app to help you find your best route based on live traffic data.
