



New Grafton bridge proposed directional signage plan

As part of the new Grafton bridge project, a proposed directional signage plan has been developed for the project. This plan is now on display for you to view and provide feedback by Friday 8 November 2019.

The proposed signage plan features different types of directional signposting to guide motorists in finding their destinations safely and efficiently when the new bridge opens to traffic.

The plan includes directional (green) and service (blue) signage, existing, amended and new tourist signposting where required (brown signs), as well as local directional signs such as hospital, airport and town centre (blue signs).

Directional signage for the project is being delivered in three stages:

- Stage 1 (during construction): focus on existing signage that needs to be updated and reinstated in similar locations to existing signs
- Stage 2 (open to traffic): includes new signage directing traffic over the new bridge and existing Pacific Highway. Heavy vehicles will be directed over the new bridge, with restrictions being added to the existing bridge
- Stage 3 (completion): involves inclusion of new signage with amended road names from the existing Pacific Highway to local road names due to opening of the Woolgoolga to Ballina project.

Roads and Maritime has developed the proposed directional signage plan in consultation with Clarence Valley Council and local businesses, and in accordance with all policies and guidelines for signposting.
