

Work outside of normal construction hours for the new Grafton bridge project

The NSW Government is funding the new \$240 million Grafton bridge. As part of the project, work outside of the normal construction hours will be carried out on Sunday, 17 December.

The approved construction hours for the project are Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturdays from 8am to 1pm. The proposed work outside of normal construction hours includes Sunday 17 December **8am to 5pm**.

Work may include installing reinforcing cages into a pile hole (which has already been drilled), preparation work for concrete pouring and drilling. It will involve the use of Maeve Anne and Rhumb barges, a crane and drilling rig.

No concrete pours will be carried out during this out of hours work.

This work will be carried out on the Clarence River (pier 6) and its northern bank, near Greaves Street within the project alignment. Due to the location and type of work, we expect minimal noise impacts to residents.
