Sportsmans Creek new bridge project – extension of temporary part closure of Grafton Street, Lawrence

The NSW Government is funding this \$27 million bridge project as part of the Bridges for the Bush program to improve road safety and traffic efficiency.

Construction work is underway on the new Sportsmans Creek bridge. To allow further earthwork to continue on and near Grafton Street, we need to extend the temporary part closure of Grafton Street until February 2017, weather permitting.

We will be working Mondays to Fridays between 7am and 6pm and possibly Saturdays from 8am to 1pm as required, weather permitting.

There will be no construction work from Saturday 24 December 2016 to Sunday 8 January 2017 inclusive. Access to all properties will be available during this time.

How will the work affect you?

Motorists accessing properties south of Lawrence Tavern from Grafton Street will continue to be detoured via the street north of Lawrence Tavern.

Traffic changes

Motorists are to follow all temporary signage and traffic control measures.
