Sportsmans Creek new bridge project – Extension to temporary part closure of Grafton Street, Lawrence.

The NSW Government is funding this \$27 million bridge project as part of the Bridges for the Bush program to improve road safety and traffic efficiency.

Roads and Maritime Services has contracted Delaney Civil Pty Ltd to build the Sportsmans Creek new bridge. Work started in July 2016 and the bridge is expected to be open to traffic in 2018, weather permitting.

To allow work to progress, part of Grafton Street has been temporarily closed to motorists since late 2016. This is to allow utilities to be relocated and the upgrade and widening of Grafton Street between the side street north of Lawrence Tavern and the properties at the northern end of the street.

This temporary closure of Grafton Street will remain in place until the bridge structure and roadworks are finished. **Grafton Street will reopen to traffic in November 2017, weather permitting.**

Access to all affected properties will continue to be available during this time.

How will the work affect you?

Motorists accessing properties south of Lawrence Tavern from Grafton Street will continue to be detoured via the street north of Lawrence Tavern.

Traffic changes

Motorists are requested to follow all temporary signage and traffic control measures.
