Start of early work and closure of Flo Clark Park boat ramp for Sportsmans Creek new bridge, Lawrence from this month

The NSW Government is funding this \$27 million bridge project as part of the Bridges for the Bush program to improve traffic efficiency and road safety.

Roads and Maritime Services will start early work this month. The work includes waterway protection measures and activities such as establishing fencing and the site office to prepare for major work.

We will be working **Mondays to Fridays** between **7am** and **6pm**, **weather permitting**.

How will the work affect you?

For the safety of river users and workers, the Flo Clark Park boat ramp will need to be closed as work progresses in the area. River users can use the boat ramp at Lawrence Memorial Park as an alternative while the new bridge is being built.

There will be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise.

Traffic changes

There may be some impact to motorists, with traffic control in place. Motorists are advised to allow additional travel time.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
