Sportsmans Creek new bridge project – temporary part closure of Grafton Street, Lawrence from September 2016

The NSW Government is funding this \$27 million bridge project as part of the Bridges for the Bush program to improve road safety and traffic efficiency.

Roads and Maritime Services has contracted Delaney Civil Pty Ltd to build the Sportsmans Creek new bridge. Early construction work started in July 2016.

To allow work to progress, Grafton Street will be temporarily closed to motorists. This will allow utilities to be relocated and the upgrade and widening of Grafton Street between the side street north of Lawrence Tavern and the properties at the northern end of the street. Access to all properties will be available during this time.

It is expected this temporary closure of Grafton Street will be in place from Wednesday 14 September until late November 2016, weather permitting. We will be working Mondays to Fridays between 7am and 6pm and Saturdays from 8am to 1pm, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

Motorists accessing properties south of Lawrence Tavern from Grafton Street will be detoured via the street north of Lawrence Tavern.

Traffic changes

Motorists are to follow all temporary signage and traffic control measures.
