## Sportsmans Creek new bridge project – temporary changes at the intersection of Weir and Ensbey roads, Lawrence from September 2016

The NSW Government is funding this \$27 million bridge project as part of the Bridges for the Bush program to improve road safety and traffic efficiency.

Roads and Maritime Services has contracted Delaney Civil Pty Ltd to build the Sportsmans Creek new bridge. Early construction work started in July 2016.

To allow work to commence on the road approach to the new bridge, a temporary side road will be in place for motorists at the intersection of Weir and Ensbey roads.

## How will the work affect you?

Motorists accessing Weir Road will travel on the temporary side road from the week commencing Monday 19 September 2016 until late 2017, weather permitting.

## **Traffic changes**

Motorists are to follow all temporary signage and traffic control measures.
