Nowra Bridge project New local road opens to traffic

The Nowra Bridge project will provide a new four lane bridge over the Shoalhaven River, upgraded intersections and additional lanes on the Princes Highway.

Shearwater Way opening

As part of the Nowra Bridge project, Shearwater Way, the new local road connecting Lyrebird Drive to the Princes Highway, will open to traffic from Wednesday 5 October 2022, weather permitting.

Shearwater Way will have a posted speed limit of 50 km/h with left in and left out access for southbound traffic on the Princes Highway.



Next steps for Pleasant Way

Pleasant Way will remain open until a later stage in the project when it will be temporarily closed while works are carried out on the southbound lanes of the Princes Highway.

This closure is required to allow us to safely complete work in this area, including building a cul-de-sac and left turn lane into Pleasant Way from the Princes Highway.

On completion of the project, only left turn movements into Pleasant Way from the Princes Highway will be permitted.

The community will be informed in advance of dates and impacts of work.
