Nowra Bridge project – Easter long weekend site shutdown and night work in April

The Nowra Bridge project will provide a new four lane bridge over the Shoalhaven River, upgraded intersections and additional lanes on the Princes Highway.

Easter long weekend site shutdown

The site will be shut down for the Easter long weekend from **6pm Thursday 1 April until 7am Tuesday 6 April**. There will be no construction work during this time however the project information line will be in operation for emergencies.

Upcoming night work

Night work will continue to be carried out on the Princes Highway, Scenic Drive, and Bolong, Illaroo and Bridge roads for the safety of workers and road users and to avoid extended traffic delays during the day.

Night work will take place across the project from **Tuesday 6 April to Friday 30 April**, weather permitting. All night work will occur **Sunday to Thursday between 6pm and 7am**.

A summary of night work activities during April is provided over the page and a map of the work areas is below.



Traffic and pedestrian changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures, stop/slow traffic conditions and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place in both directions on the Princes Highway and Bolong, Illaroo and Bridge roads during scheduled night work. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

The footpath on the northbound bridge and the lower eastern footpath to the southern foreshore will be closed during some of these night work activities. Signage will be in place advising of detours during these closures.

How will the work affect you?

During this work we will be using machinery and equipment that generate light, noise and vibration. We will make every effort to minimise disruption. Residents will have access to and from their properties at all times and properties affected by utility service outages will be notified separately by the service provider.

Oversize machinery and equipment may be delivered to these areas at night to avoid extended traffic delays during the day. Marine machinery is also being mobilised to site and some of this machinery may be delivered at night during high tide.

Illaroo Road	Placing and removing temporary traffic barriers, service investigation work and relocating sewer, gas, electrical and communication services.	Up to 18 nights
Princes Highway (between Shoalhaven River and Moss Street)	Placing and removing temporary traffic barriers, signage and street lighting, installing kerb and gutter, asphalt paving, installing drainage, loading and placement of material, service investigation work and relocating electrical and communication services.	Up to 18 nights
Bridge Road	Service investigation work and relocating communication services.	Up to 18 nights
Scenic Drive compound	General office activities, pre-starts, vehicle movements and deliveries.	Up to 18 nights
Casting yard and temporary rock platform	Continuing with piling activities including placing reinforcement, moving barges and machinery and unloading, positioning, drilling and welding piles.	Monday to Friday until 7pm, with up to four occasions until 8pm
	To ensure the quality and strength of the concrete in the piers of the new bridge, we may complete overnight concrete pours. The first concrete pour is scheduled for early April.	Up to three nights per week
