Nowra Bridge project - Night work in June


The Nowra Bridge project will provide a new four lane bridge over the Shoalhaven River, upgraded intersections and additional lanes on the Princes Highway.

Upcoming night work

Night work will continue to be carried out on the Princes Highway, Scenic Drive, and Bolong, Illaroo and Bridge roads for the safety of workers and road users and to avoid extended traffic delays during the day.

Night work will take place across the project from **Tuesday 1 June to Wednesday 30 June**, weather permitting. Night work will occur **between 6pm and 7am**. The site will be shut down for the long weekend in June from **6pm Friday 11 June until 7am Tuesday 15 June**.

A summary of night work activities during June is provided over the page and a map of the work areas is below.



Traffic and pedestrian changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures, stop/slow traffic conditions and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place in both directions on the Princes Highway and Bolong, Illaroo and Bridge roads during the night work. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.


There will be footpath detours during some of these night work activities. This will include the northbound bridge footpath, the underpass between Harry Sawkins Park and Campbell Place and the Princes Highway footpath north of Bolong Road. Signage will be in place advising of detours during these closures.

Bolong Road	Placing and removing temporary traffic barriers, loading and placement of material, service investigation work, installing and commissioning electrical and telecommunications services.	Up to 20 nights
Princes Highway (between Mattes Way and Illaroo Road)	Placing and removing temporary traffic barriers, loading and placement of material, relocating signage, street lighting, installing drainage, kerb and footpaths, service investigation work, installing and commissioning electrical, sewer and telecommunications services.	Up to 20 nights
Illaroo Road	Placing and removing temporary traffic barriers, asphalt paving, line marking, removal of kerb, installing drainage, kerb and footpaths, service investigation, installing and commissioning electrical, sewer and telecommunications services.	Up to 15 nights
Princes Highway (between Shoalhaven River and Moss Street)	Placing and removing temporary traffic barriers, loading and placement of material, relocating signage and street lighting, asphalt paving, installing and commissioning electrical and telecommunications services.	Up to 20 nights
Bridge Road	Placing and removing temporary traffic barriers, installing kerb and gutter, loading and placement of material, installing street lighting and drainage, installing and commissioning electrical and telecommunications services.	Up to 20 nights
Scenic Drive compound	General office activities, pre-starts, vehicle movements and deliveries.	Up to 20 nights
Casting yard and temporary rock platform	Continuing with piling activities including placing reinforcement, moving barges and machinery and unloading, positioning, drilling and welding piles.	Monday to Friday until 7pm, with up to four occasions until 8pm.
	To ensure the quality and strength of the concrete elements of the new bridge, we will complete overnight concrete pours for the piers and bridge deck structures. These concrete pours may start as early as midnight to 2am and continue into normal working hours. This work will involve delivery of concrete to site, concrete pump trucks, and use of vibration equipment to place and compact concrete.	Up to four overnight concrete pours.

How will the work affect you?

During this work we will be using machinery and equipment that generate light, noise and vibration. We will make every effort to minimise disruption. Residents will have access to and from their properties at all times and properties affected by utility service outages will be notified separately by the service provider.

Oversize machinery and equipment may be delivered to these areas at night to avoid extended traffic delays during the day.
