Night work on the Princes Highway and local roads, Nowra

The NSW and Australian Governments are funding a new four lane bridge over the Shoalhaven River, upgraded intersections and additional lanes on the Princes Highway.

We are continuing to carry out vegetation removal and pavement investigations on the Princes Highway, Bolong Road, Illaroo Road and Bridge Road as part of the Nowra Bridge project. This work will allow us to start construction at these locations later this year.

The work will be carried out from **Sunday 2 August** for up to five nights (weather permitting). Our work hours will be between **6pm and 5am** to reduce the impacts to motorists and pedestrians.

Should the work need to be postponed, new dates will be advertised on variable message signs and on the project website. A map of the work area is provided over the page.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise and light associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise disruption to residents by scheduling noisier activities earlier in the night. Where possible, we will position equipment away from properties and turn off machinery when not in use. Residents will have access to and from their properties at all times.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place on the Princes Highway in both directions, on Bridge Road, Illaroo Road and Bolong Road during the night work. Motorists should allow up to 10 minutes extra travel time during night work.


