Changed traffic conditions on Bridge Road

The Nowra Bridge project will provide a new four lane bridge over the Shoalhaven River, upgraded intersections and additional lanes on the Princes Highway.

Temporary closure of Bridge Road

As we get closer to the final stage before the new bridge opens to traffic, work to prepare the surrounding roads and approaches will be carried out.

Bridge Road, between the Princes Highway and Hyam Street, will be temporarily closed while work is carried out to replace road pavement near the intersection with the Princes Highway.

Work will be carried out from **7pm Sunday 15 January to 6am Wednesday 18 January 2023**, weather permitting.

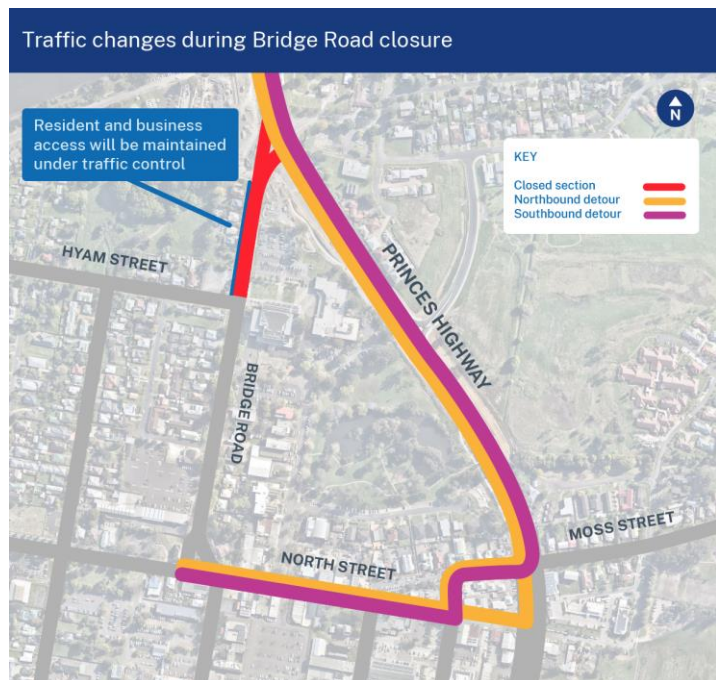
Detours will be in place

Southbound road users on the Princes Highway will be detoured via Moss Street to access the Nowra CBD. Road users wanting to access the northbound lanes of the Princes Highway will be detoured via North Street, Moss Street and surrounding local roads.

Resident and business access will be maintained under traffic control between the Princes Highway and Hyam Street.

Electronic signs will be in place before and during these changes to advertise detours in advance. Road users are advised to drive to the conditions, and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.

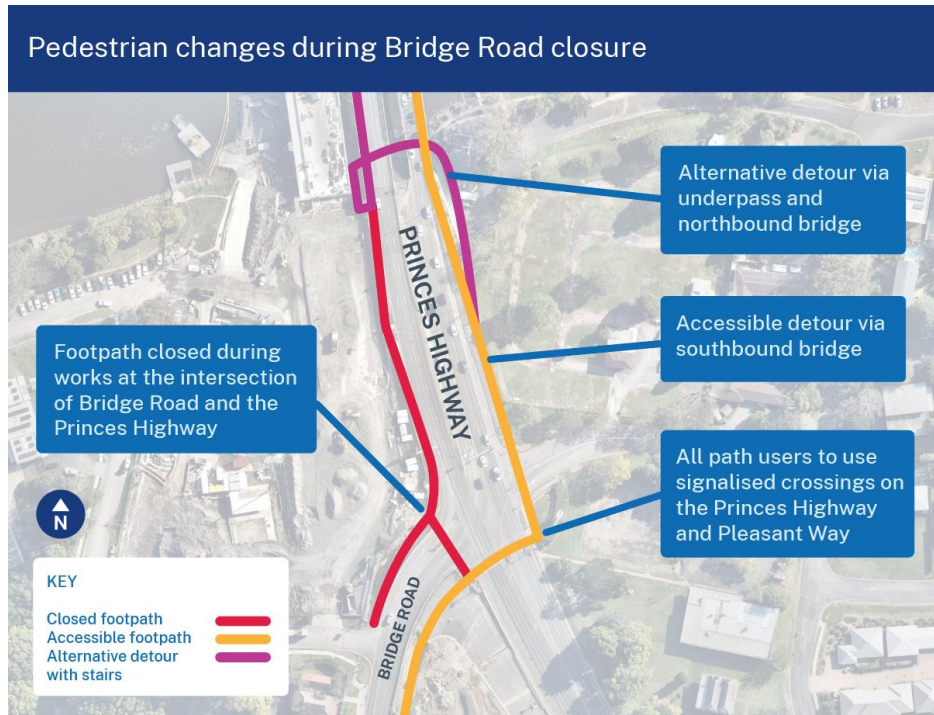
Bridge Road will be required to close for a second time in late February, before the new bridge opens to traffic.
