Night work on the Princes Highway, Nowra

Work is progressing on the Nowra Bridge project, with construction expected to be complete in mid-2024.



Night work will occur on the Princes Highway, Nowra

What are we doing?

We are carrying out work within and adjacent to the Princes Highway as part of the Nowra Bridge project. Work will include vegetation removal between Illaroo and Bolong Roads, as well as pavement investigations between Mattes Way and Moss Street.

The work will be carried out from **Sunday 12 July** for up to four nights (weather permitting). Our work hours will be between **6pm and 5am** to reduce the impacts to motorists and pedestrians.

Should the work need to be postponed, new dates will be advertised on variable message signs and on the project website. A map of the work area is provided over the page.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise and light associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise disruption to residents by scheduling noisier activities earlier in the night. Where possible, we will position equipment away from properties and turn off machinery when not in use.

Residents will have access to and from their properties at all times.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary lane closures on the Princes Highway between Moss Street, Nowra and Mattes Way, Bomaderry during the night work. Motorists should allow up to 10 minutes additional travel time during night work. Stop/slow traffic control and a reduced speed limit of 40km/hr will also be in place for the safety of motorists and our workers.
