

# Restoration work continues, Oxley Highway, Mount Seaview

January 2023

The NSW Government is funding essential reconstruction work on the Oxley Highway at Mount Seaview to reinstate full access through natural disaster affected areas.

We are continuing major restoration work on the Oxley Highway at Mount Seaview to return the road to pre-2021 flood condition.

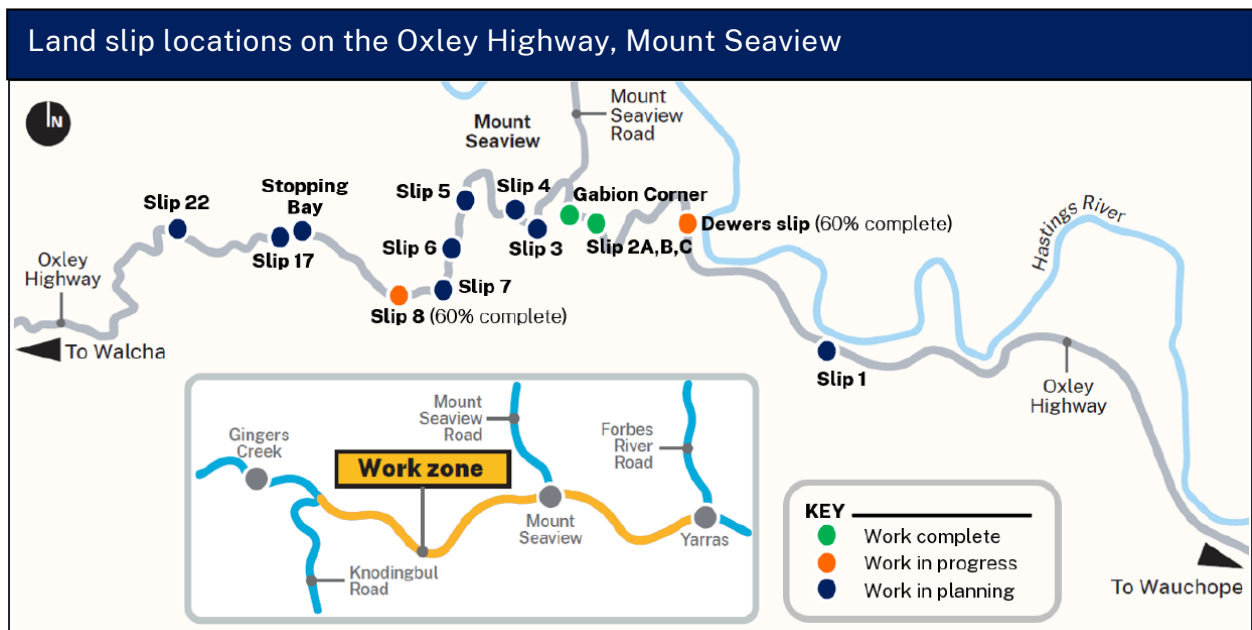
From Monday 9 January, restoration work will resume at various locations between Knodingbut and Forbes River roads. This work involves:

- finalising the current stabilisation work
- building surface drainage
- replacing culverts
- restoring pavement.

Our work hours are from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday. No work is planned to be carried out on Sundays or public holidays.

The next phase of the major slope stabilisation work is expected to start in July 2023. As we progress to more complex slip sites, full road closures will be required.

We will keep the community informed of the nature and timing of planned road closures well in advance.

## Traffic changes

Single lane, alternating traffic flow arrangements and reduced speed limits will be in place. Short stoppages of up to 15 minutes may be required during work hours.
