

Weekend night work on the Pacific Highway duplication at Lisarow from Saturday 15 January

The NSW Government is investing \$178 million to duplicate the Pacific Highway between Ourimbah Street and Parsons Road, Lisarow to improve traffic flow and safety.

Work within the rail corridor must be timed to occur at times when the rail line is closed for maintenance.

We will be working continuously from **1pm on Saturday 15 up to 4.30am on Sunday 16 January** during the scheduled rail shutdown, weather permitting.

We will be working on the old rail bridge near the Pacific Highway and Railway Crescent intersection to prepare for its removal. We have included a map below to show the work area.

How will work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. Noise blankets will also be used around stationary plant, where possible.

Directly affected residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption during the work.

Traffic changes

There will be short term intermittent stops and a temporary 40 km/h reduced speed limit will be in place through the work zone for the safety of motorists and workers. Motorists are advised to allow extra travel time.
