Out of hours work on the Pacific Highway duplication at Lisarow from Wednesday 1 June

The NSW Government is investing \$178 million to duplicate the Pacific Highway between Ourimbah Street and Parsons Road, Lisarow to improve traffic flow and safety.

We are working between **7am and 6pm** on **weekdays** and **8am and 1pm** on **Saturdays**. Some out of hours work is required for the safety of motorists and workers to ensure work on the project is carried out as efficiently as possible.

Night work will be carried out on the upgrade between 1 June and 30 June 2022 between 8pm and 5am Sunday to Thursday, weather permitting. We will also be working on Saturday between 8am and 5pm in different areas across the project and continuously over a weekend during the rail shutdown.

Below is a list of the upcoming planned out of hours work for June:

Activity	Duration
Utility services relocation on The Ridgeway near the intersection of the Pacific Highway and near Lisarow High School	1 night
Building and concreting new access into BJ Howes Metaland	2 x Saturdays 3 nights 1 night
Asphalting on the Pacific Highway between Parsons Road and The Ridgeway (if not completed in May)	3 nights
Delivery of bridge girders to the northern compound (girders are delivered at night and trucks will be parked up and unloaded during normal construction hours)	Up to three times per week in June
Work on the new bridge over the railway line	4 x Saturdays 48 hours continuous work during rail shutdown weekend
Delivery of plant and equipment to site and accessing site compounds on Railway Crescent, Macdonalds Road and the northern compounds on the Pacific Highway

How will the work affect you?

Out of hours work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. Noise blankets will also be used around stationary plant equipment, where possible.

Directly affected residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption during the work.

Traffic changes

Lane closures and traffic control will be in place during the work and may affect travel times. There may be short term intermittent stops and a temporary 40 km/h reduced speed limit will be in place through the work zones for the safety of motorists and workers.


