

Weekend and night work on the Pacific Highway duplication at Lisarow from Friday 22 July

The NSW Government is investing \$178 million to duplicate the Pacific Highway between Ourimbah Street and Parsons Road, Lisarow to improve traffic flow and safety.

Work within the rail corridor must be timed to occur at times when the rail line is closed for maintenance.

We will be working continuously from **midnight on Friday 22 July to midnight on Sunday 24 July** during the scheduled rail shutdown to install bridge girders that support the new bridge within the rail corridor.

We will also be working at night between **6pm and 5am on Monday 25 July and Tuesday 26 July** to install the remaining bridge girders outside the rail corridor.

The bridge girders are being installed on the new rail bridge near the Pacific Highway and Railway Crescent intersection. We will be loading the girders at the northern compound using a crane transporting them along the highway on oversized trucks to the location of the new bridge where they will be installed using heavy lifting cranes.

We have included a map below to show the work area.

How will work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. Noise blankets will also be used around stationary plant, where possible.

Directly affected residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption during the work.

Traffic changes

There will be short term intermittent stops and there will be one lane operating in each direction within the work zone. A temporary 40 km/h reduced speed limit will be in place through the work zone for the safety of motorists and workers. Motorists are advised to allow extra travel time.

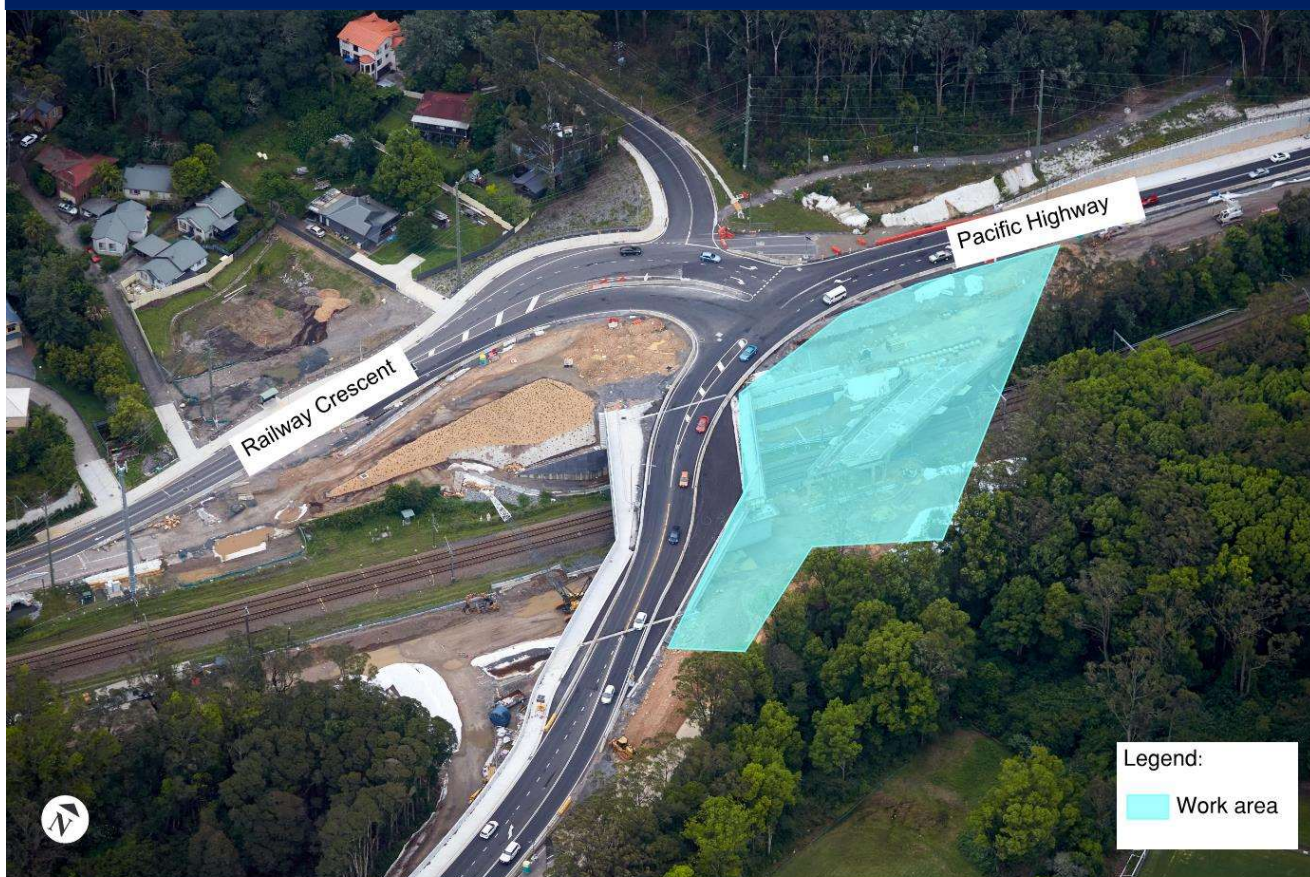
