

## Weekend and night work on the Pacific Highway duplication at Lisarow from Saturday 10 September

The NSW Government is investing \$178 million to duplicate the Pacific Highway between Ourimbah Street and Parsons Road, Lisarow to improve traffic flow and safety.

Work within the rail corridor must be timed to occur when the rail line is closed for maintenance.

We will be working continuously from **6am on Saturday 10 September to 8.30pm on Sunday 11 September** during the scheduled rail shutdown to complete ongoing work within the rail corridor, including removal of vegetation and drainage work.

We have included a map below to show the work area.

### How will work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. Noise blankets will also be used around stationary plant, where possible.

**Directly affected residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption during the work.**
