



## Temporary closure of The Ridgeway, Lisarow during night work from Monday 23 August

The NSW Government is investing \$178 million to duplicate the Pacific Highway between Ourimbah Street and Parsons Road, Lisarow to improve traffic flow and safety.

The Ridgeway will be closed to all through traffic near its intersection with the Pacific Highway during night work on **Monday 23**, **Tuesday 24 and Wednesday 25 August** between **8pm and 5am**.

Access for Emergency Services, local traffic and pedestrians will maintained during the closure.

The Ridgeway needs to be closed to allow work to continue on the Pacific Highway duplication, including asphalting the new road alignment at the intersection of The Ridgeway and the Pacific Highway and relocation of the traffic lights.

Road users will be detoured via Nexus Way and Macdonalds Road to access the Pacific Highway. We have included a map to show the detour route.

## How will work affect you?

We will be working at night to implement the changes to traffic on the Pacific Highway between The Ridgeway and Parsons Road. The night work will be **from Monday 23 to Wednesday 25 August between 8pm and 5am.** 

The night work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. Noise blankets will also be used around stationary plant, where possible.

Directly affected residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption during the work.
