

Weekend work near Railway Crescent and Pacific Highway, Lisarow from Saturday 30 October

The NSW Government is investing \$178 million to duplicate the Pacific Highway between Ourimbah Street and Parsons Road, Lisarow to improve traffic flow and safety.

Work within the rail corridor must be timed to occur on weekends when the rail line is closed for maintenance.

We will be working **6am to 6pm on Saturday 30 October and Sunday 31 October** during the next scheduled rail shutdown, weather permitting.

Work includes preparation to remove the existing bridge across the rail line near the Pacific Highway and Railway Crescent intersection. We have included a map to show where the work will be carried out.

How will the work affect you?

The out of hours work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise. We will carry out noise monitoring during work hours.

Directly affected residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption during the work.

Traffic changes

Lane closures and traffic control will be in place during the work and may affect travel times. There may be short term intermittent stops and a temporary 40 km/h reduced speed limit will be in place through the work zones for the safety of motorists and workers.
