

## Pacific Highway Upgrade

### Permanent change to traffic conditions

#### November 2022

The NSW Government is funding improvements at intersections on the Pacific Highway at Redleaf Avenue, Coonanbarra Road and Fox Valley Road to ease congestion and improve traffic flow.

As part of the project, we have been implementing new traffic measures at intersections including Marshall Avenue and Coonanbarra Road to provide safe and controlled turning movements.

#### 'No Right Turn' at Coonanbarra Road

The 'No right turn' from Pacific Highway into Coonanbarra Road at Wahroonga will come into effect from **Monday 21 November**.

The works on this road will create three through lanes, and this will mean the right lane at Coonanbarra Road will become a straight through road. These changes will help to improve traffic flow and reduce congestion within the area.

This no-right turn was detailed in the Review of Environmental Factors, approved in 2019.

#### New signalised intersection at Redleaf Avenue

Construction of the new **signalised intersection** at Redleaf Avenue is nearing completion. From **21 November**, the intersection will provide a safer right turn option into Redleaf Avenue from Pacific Highway, which provides access to the Wahroonga Shopping Village, train station and residential properties in the area. The new intersection will also include signalised pedestrian crossings of Pacific Highway and Redleaf Avenue.

#### Our work schedules

Our standard construction hours remain as **Sundays to Thursdays from 8pm to 5am**. Our works are scheduled during the night to minimise

traffic impacts and increase safety for the public and our workers.

#### How will this impact you?

Variable messaging signs (VMS) will be in place on Pacific Highway to give you advance notice of traffic changes.

Please ensure you drive carefully with these changed traffic conditions and follow directions and information provided on signage and by traffic controllers.

Local traffic travelling north on Pacific Highway wanting to access Coonanbarra Road will need to utilise the right turn at Redleaf Avenue. Alternative routes to access Coonanbarra Road include Ada Avenue via Lucinda Avenue and Fox Valley Road.
