

Project Notification - Investigation work on Pacific Highway, between Turramurra and Wahroonga

The NSW Government is investigating potential Pacific Highway upgrades as part of its \$300 million Urban Roads Pinch Point Program, which aims to reduce congestion and improve travel times on Sydney's busiest corridors.

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out utilities survey and geotechnical investigation work, to assist potential upgrade planning and development.

Investigation work will take place at:

- Pacific Highway between Ray Street and Ku-Ring-Gai Avenue, Turramurra
- Pacific Highway at Finlay Road, Warrawee/Turramurra
- Pacific Highway and Fox Valley Road, Wahroonga/ Warrawee
- Pacific Highway at Coonanbarra Road and Redleaf Avenue, Wahroonga.

Proposed work includes locating under and above ground utilities, geotechnical test pits, pavement cores and deep boreholes. We have included a map to show the locations of the work.

Our work schedule

Work is expected to commence **Wednesday, 7 March, 2018** and will take approximately **14 weeks** to complete, weather permitting. We anticipate completing works by **Wednesday, 13 June, 2018**.

Our day time work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm**, from **Monday** to **Friday**. There may be some works on **Saturdays**, between **7.00am** and **1.00pm**, if required. We will not be working on public holidays.

At times we will need to work at night for up to **two night shifts per week** at any of the above intersections. Our night work hours will be between **8.00pm** and **5am**, from **Sunday** to **Thursday**.

How will the work affect you?

We will do everything we can to minimise the impact of the work, including working at different locations along the road. Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier activities, like saw-cutting concrete, jack-hammering and breaking up concrete, by **midnight**.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures may be required, which may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
