

Tree removal work on Paytens Bridge Road from Monday 12 December

The NSW Government is providing \$250,000 development funding to investigate options to replace Paytens Bridge on Paytens Bridge Road.

Transport for NSW will carry out the work, which includes trimming and removal of a small number of trees near the bridge to provide access to the Lachlan River for geotechnical investigations.

We will be working between **7am** and **5pm Monday to Friday** and expect to complete the work in **three days**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.
