The NSW Government committed \$5 million to build a pedestrian bridge on Pennant Hills Road, North Parramatta near Masons Drive.

Roads and Maritime Services has now completed this project.

We have included a photo of the completed pedestrian bridge.

Open to foot traffic

The pedestrian bridge was opened to foot traffic on Monday 29 January 2018, to coincide with the commencement of the school year.

The project is now complete and included:

- building the foundation of the bridge
- moving and protecting the heritage pillars
- building a retaining wall
- building and painting the lift shafts and stairs
- installing and commissioning the lifts and related electrical work
- lifting the bridge into place
- landscaping.
