Start of work on pedestrian bridge on Pennant Hills Road, North Parramatta, from Monday 31 July

The NSW Government is funding this \$5 million project to provide a safe crossing over Pennant Hills Road for local students, other pedestrians and cyclists.

Roads and Maritime Services is building a pedestrian bridge over Pennant Hills Road, North Parramatta.

We invited feedback on the proposal and night work schedule in March 2016 and February 2017. We notified the community and stakeholders in February and May 2017 that we would be proceeding with the project.

Our work schedule

We will be on site to build the pedestrian bridge for 40 night shifts and 220 day shifts between Monday 31 July and Monday 30 April, excluding public holidays, weather permitting. Our night work hours will be between 7pm and 5am from Sunday to Friday. Our day work hours will be between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday and between 8am and 1pm on Saturday.

The first stage of work will include:

- removing the fig tree on the corner of Pennant Hills Road and Glencoe Avenue
- clearing vegetation
- setting up the site compound and temporary fencing
- reinforcing the retaining wall on the corner of Pennant Hills Road and Glencoe Drive.

We have included a map to show the location of the work.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **11pm**.
