Princes Highway Upgrade, Kirrawee – Appointment of interim contractor

Project update | February 2021



Transport for NSW has appointed a contractor to undertake targeted interim works while we finalise the appointment of the new main contractor to complete the whole project.

Christie Civil Pty Ltd will commence interim works on Monday, 8 February 2021 and will primarily be working at Oak Road, Bath Road, Acacia Road North, and sections of the Service Road.

We will keep you up-to-date on the appointment of the main contractor, who will begin work in March 2021 to complete the Acacia Road, Oak Road, Kingsway and President Avenue upgrades along the Princes Highway.

Interim works include:

- drainage works
- kerb and gutter
- footpath and general concrete works
- associated civil works.

Interim Work Schedule

Christie Civil Pty Ltd will carry out interim work from 8 February 2021 for approximately four weeks, weather permitting. They will be on site up to six days a week. They will only be working five night shifts throughout the month, weather permitting.


Their day shift hours will be **7am–6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and **8am–5pm** on **Saturday**. Their night shift hours will be **Monday to Friday 8pm–5am** for only five night shifts throughout the month.
