



Night work on Prospect Highway and traffic changes on the Great Western Highway and M4 Motorway

10 January 2022

The NSW Government is upgrading Prospect Highway between Reservoir Road, Prospect and St Martins Crescent, Blacktown to reduce congestion and help meet future traffic demands on this corridor.

Transport for NSW has appointed Fulton Hogan to deliver the Prospect Highway upgrade between Reservoir Road, Prospect and St Martins Crescent, Blacktown. The upgrade will improve travel time, safety and reduce congestion for all road users.

As part of the early works, preparation for the construction of the new bridges on the Prospect Highway over the Great Western Highway and M4 Motorway will begin. Temporary pavement work will take place in the median and shoulder lanes of the Great Western Highway and the M4 Motorway in both directions.

This work will include the installation of safety barriers, new line marking and the reconfiguration of traffic both eastbound and westbound on the Great Western Highway and M4 Motorway.

Temporary pavement work and utilities investigations will also be carried out at the Prospect Highway and Reservoir Road intersection and on the Prospect Highway south of the intersection.

Vegetation and some tree clearing is required for the upgrade and temporary pavement work will also be carried out at the Prospect Highway and M4 eastbound ramp intersection.

Our work schedule

This work will be carried out in 35 shifts at night to lessen the disturbance on traffic and improve safety for workers and road users. Night work will be carried out from Sunday 16 January 2022 to Friday 25 February 2022, excluding public holidays and weather permitting.

Our work hours will be:

Night – Sunday to Thursday: 9pm to 5am

How will the work affect you?

Our work will be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance of this work on surrounding residents and businesses. Noise reduction measures will be in place including using non-tonal reversing alarms on heavy vehicles, switching off plant equipment when not in use and staging the work in different locations. Any high noise work such as cutting the road pavement will be carried out before 11pm.


Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes and lane closures on the eastbound and westbound lanes of the Great Western Highway and M4 Motorway during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Reduced speed limits will be in place. Electronic message signs will also be in place to direct road users through these changes. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

Our work may affect travel times so please allow additional travel time.
