BUILDING OUR FUTURE

Work continuing on Prospect Highway and traffic changes on the Great Western Highway and M4 Motorway

February 2022

The Australian and NSW Governments are upgrading Prospect Highway between Reservoir Road, Prospect and St Martins Crescent, Blacktown to reduce congestion and help meet future traffic demands on this corridor.

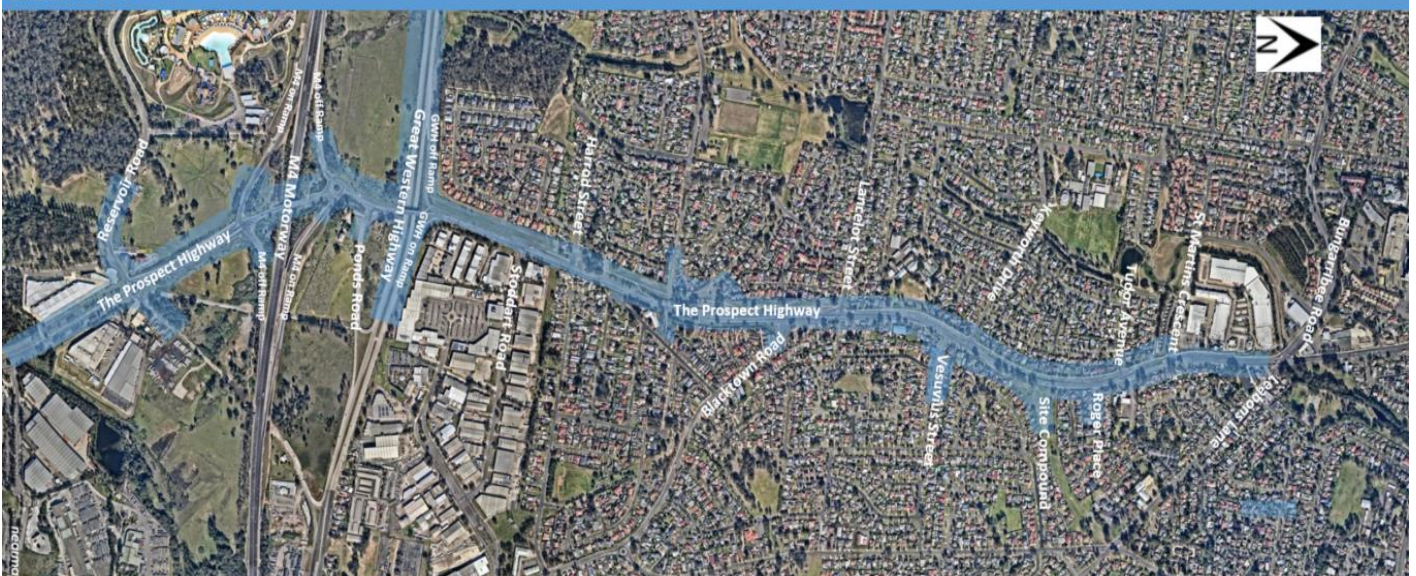
The upgrade will improve travel time, safety and reduce congestion for all road users. Construction of the new bridges on the Prospect Highway over the Great Western Highway and M4 Motorway will continue, requiring temporary closure of some lanes on the Great Western Highway and the M4 Motorway in both directions.

This work will include the installation of safety barriers, new line marking and the reconfiguration of traffic both eastbound and westbound on the Great Western Highway and M4 Motorway. As part of the works speed reductions will remain in place for approximately 12 months to enable construction of the bridges.

Additional work activities will include tree and vegetation removal, piling and foundation works, saw cutting of existing pavements, earthworks, hammering and excavation work, construction and installation of new concrete structures for the new bridge construction. Earthworks will also be carried out on the Great Western Highway and M4 eastbound and westbound on and off ramps.

Work will also continue work on the Prospect Highway between the Reservoir Road intersection and Bungarribee Road, including new line marking to realign traffic both northbound and southbound. Works include temporary pavement work, earthworks, hammering and excavation, installation of safety barriers and project signage, utilities relocations including trenching and stormwater drainage, property adjustment work, plant and material deliveries and vegetation and tree clearing.

Our work schedule

Some of this work will be carried out at night to lessen the disruption to traffic and improve safety for workers and road users. Night work will be carried out from **Sunday 27 February 2022 to Thursday 19 May 2022**, excluding public holidays and weather permitting.

During this time our work hours will be:

- Day – Monday to Friday: 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm
- Night – Sunday to Thursday: 8pm to 5am

How will the work affect you?

Our work will be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance of this work on surrounding residents and businesses. Noise reduction measures will be in place including using non-tonal (quieter) reversing alarms on heavy vehicles, switching off plant equipment when not in use and staging the work in different locations. Any high noise impact works such as cutting the road pavement will be undertaken before 11pm.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes and temporary closure of some lanes on the eastbound and westbound lanes of the Great Western Highway and M4 Motorway during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Scheduled weekend lane closures will also be in place on the Great Western Highway during these dates.

Speed on this section of the Great Western Highway will be reduced to 60km/h from Sunday 27 February. Speed has also recently been reduced to 80km/h on the M4 Motorway.

Within the work zone, further speed reductions will be in place at night. Electronic message signs will display these speed changes. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

Our work may affect travel times so please allow additional travel time.
