

Work continuing on new roundabout at Hadrian Avenue and Keyworth Drive, Prospect and kiss and ride facility at Shelley Public School

September 2021

The NSW Government is upgrading Prospect Highway between Reservoir Road, Prospect and St Martins Crescent, Blacktown to reduce congestion and help meet future traffic demands on this corridor.

Transport for NSW is continuing to carry out early work on the Prospect Highway upgrade between Blacktown Road and St Martins Crescent. This work includes the installation of a new roundabout at the intersection of Keyworth Drive and Hadrian Road to improve safety and traffic flow and a kiss and ride facility at Shelly Public School.

Since June 2021, we have:

- completed stormwater drainage works
- installed new kerb and gutter
- completed road resurfacing and asphalting

Over the coming months, we will:

- complete the roundabout
- add final layer of asphalt
- install footpath
- complete line marking
- complete the kiss and ride facility at Shelley Public School

The safety and wellbeing of our workforce and the wider community is our highest priority. This work is in line with the Public Health Order and a COVID-Safe plan is in place, including masks and QR codes.

Our work schedule

Work is expected to be completed by the end of 2021.

Our work hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturday, weather permitting.

We will not work on public holidays.



Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes including road closures to make the work zone is safe. Traffic control will be in place to direct road users through these changes. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

During construction, we will do our best to maintain access to driveways. However, there may be instances where driveways cannot be accessed.

Residents will be directly notified in advance of upcoming work.
