

Night work continuing at the Prospect Highway and Stoddard Road intersection, Prospect from Wednesday 1 September

The NSW Government is upgrading Prospect Highway between Reservoir Road, Prospect and St Martins Crescent, Blacktown to reduce congestion and help meet future traffic demands on this corridor.

Transport for NSW has engaged Ausconnex to carry out early work on Prospect Highway between Blacktown Road and St Martins Crescent. Over the next three months, Ausconnex will carry out key utility relocation work required for the future upgrade.

This work includes relocating the existing 33KV and 11KV electrical network at the Prospect Highway and Stoddard Road intersection.

The safety and wellbeing of our workforce and the wider community is our highest priority. This work is in line with the Public Health Order and a COVIDSafe plan is in place, including masks and QR codes.

Our work schedule

We need to carry out some of this work at night to lessen the disturbance to traffic and improve safety for workers and road users. We will be on site for up to 10 night shifts between Wednesday 1 September and Thursday 30 September, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be:

- Monday to Sunday: 9pm to 5am

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times during the night time but we will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance of this work on surrounding residents and businesses. Any high noise impact works such as cutting the road asphalt will be undertaken before 11pm.

We will carry out this work in accordance with the NSW Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) and the Environmental Protection Licence (EPL) requirements including the following to provide some relief:

:

- no more than two consecutive evenings or nights per week
- no more than three evenings or nights per week
- no more than 10 evenings or nights per month

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
