



Project update - work resuming at the intersection of Bells Line of Road and Grose Vale Road/Terrace Road, North Richmond, from Monday 8 January 2018

Roads and Maritime Services | December 2017

The Australian and NSW Governments are improving traffic conditions at key intersections on approach to Richmond Bridge.

Roads and Maritime Services is delivering this project, which involves improving the intersection of Bells Line of Road/Terrace Road and Grose Vale Road, North Richmond.

The project will improve travel times and traffic flows during peak periods.

Project progress and next stage

We have surveyed the site, identified the location of utilities, completed some tree removal, carried out some demolition work and most property adjustments. The work to be done in the New Year includes:

- further property adjustments
- removing vegetation
- relocating utilities
- installing or improving dedicated turning lanes on all sides of the intersection
- providing two westbound lanes from Pitt Lane to approximately 90 metres west of Grose Vale Road
- removing about 21 parking spaces and relocating bus zones
- installing seven 15 minute parking spaces on the eastbound side of Bells Line of Road.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

Our work schedule

We will be back on site to complete the third stage of work for another 66 night shifts and 65 day shifts between Monday 8 January and Friday 27 April, weather permitting.

Our night work hours will be between **7pm** and **7am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**. Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **7pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturdays**. We will not be working on public holidays.

The project team will not be on site at all times because of the way we are staging the program of work.

We have included a map to show the location of the work.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will continue to do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **midnight** and staging them in different locations.

The service road will remain operational during this stage of work and there will be no changes to parking. We will notify the community again of any changes.


