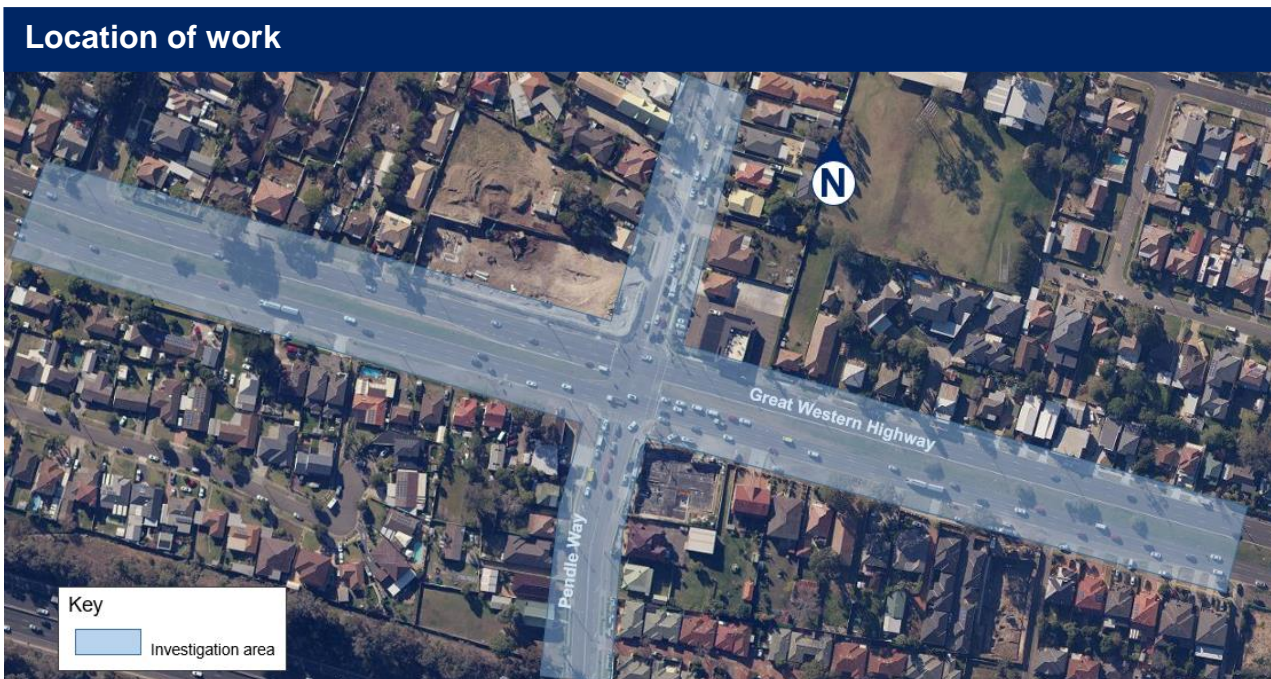
Investigations on Great Western Highway and Pendle Way, Pendle Hill from Monday 27 September

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing more than \$400 million to improve safety and reduce crashes on NSW roads.

Transport for NSW will be conducting investigations at Great Western Highway and Pendle Way in Pendle Hill to help plan for future road safety improvements at the area.

We will be investigating ground surface and above ground conditions, placement of underground utilities including drainage and taking soil samples to enable the commencement of a design. We will be on site from Monday 27 September to Friday 3 December, weather permitting.

Road safety stimulus projects

Pendle Hill, Parramatta and Ermington have been earmarked for road safety improvements as part of a more than \$400 million investment by the Australian and NSW Governments to deliver hundreds of road safety projects across NSW, designed to reduce road trauma and save lives. These projects will also support more than 2,500 direct and indirect jobs as the economy recovers from COVID-19.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for up to **15** day shifts and **25** night shifts between **Monday 27 September** and **Friday 3 December**, weather permitting.

Our day work hours will be from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and from **8am to 1pm on Saturday**. Our night work hours will be between **Sunday and Thursday**, from **8pm to 5am** the next day.

How will the work affect you?

Some of our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers and motorists.

It may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **midnight**. We will stage our work in order to ensure we do not work more than two nights in any week, or more than six nights in one month in any one location.

These works are in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID Safety Plan is in place, including QR codes and masks.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
