## Investigation work at the intersection of Great Western Highway and Pendle Way, Pendle Hill, from Monday 24 January

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing more than \$400 million to improve safety and reduce crashes on NSW roads.

Transport for NSW will be conducting investigation work at the intersection of Great Western Highway and Pendle Way at Pendle Hill. This work will help plan for future road safety improvements in the area.

We will be undertaking utilities and geotechnical investigations including some trenching and potholing. The below map shows the location of our work.



### Road safety stimulus projects

Pendle Hill, Parramatta and Ermington have been earmarked for road safety improvements as part of a more than \$400 million investment by the Australian and NSW Governments to deliver hundreds of road safety projects across NSW, designed to reduce road trauma and save lives. These projects will also support more than 2,500 direct and indirect jobs as the economy recovers from COVID-19.

## Our work schedule

We will be on site for **two** night shifts between **Monday 24 January** and **Friday 18 March**, weather permitting.

Our night work hours will be between **Sunday** and **Thursday**, from **8pm to 5am** the next day.

## How will the work affect you?

Some of our work will need to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers and motorists.

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **midnight**. We will stage our work to ensure we do not work for more than two nights in any week in any one location.

This work is in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID-19 Safe plan is in place.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
