Work Continuing at James Ruse Drive and Prospect Street, Rosehill from Friday 6 January 2023

December 2022

Transport for NSW is upgrading the traffic lights at the intersection of James Ruse Drive and Prospect Street, Rosehill as part of the Road Safety Stimulus Program. Traffic light displays are being upgraded to improve traffic flow and increase safety at the intersection for pedestrians and road users. The location of the work is shown on the map overleaf.

We had expected to have this work completed by Friday 30 December 2022. However, due to unforeseen circumstances, we will continue to be on site for up to **ten night shifts** between **Friday 6 January** and **Tuesday 28 February 2023**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will continue to be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday to Friday**. We will work up to five nights a week to get the work done as quickly as possible. We will not work on public holidays.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times.
