# Road work on Miller Street and Palmer Street, Cammeray from Sunday 21 August

Project update – August 2022

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing more than \$400 million to improve safety and reduce crashes on NSW roads.

Transport for NSW is increasing pedestrian safety and providing consistent driving conditions at the intersection of Miller Street and Palmer Street in Cammeray by introducing a new signalised pedestrian crossing at this location.

Work will commence on **Sunday 21 August** and is expected to be complete by **Friday 9 September 2022**, weather permitting.

## Road safety stimulus projects

The Miller Street and Palmer Street intersection in Cammeray has been earmarked for road safety improvements as part of a more than \$400 million investment by the Australian and NSW Governments to deliver hundreds of road safety projects across NSW, designed to reduce road trauma and save lives. These projects will also support more than 2,500 direct and indirect jobs as the economy recovers from COVID-19.

## Our work schedule

We will be on site for **six night shifts** between **Sunday 21 August and Friday 9 September 2022**, weather permitting.

Our night work hours will be between **Sunday and Thursday, from 8pm to 5am the next day.**

## How will the work affect you?

There will be minor disruptions on the road, and to traffic and residents or businesses. Where we can, our work will occur during the day. However, we will need to carry out some of work at night for no more than two nights per week.

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to reduce the disturbance to the community including turning off equipment when not in use and completing the noisier tasks before midnight.

This work is in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID-19 Safe Plan is in place.

## Traffic changes

There will be temporary lane closures during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe which may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs in the investigation area.
