Rydalmere Wharf upgrade

Rydalmere Wharf will be temporarily closed from **Wednesday 3 October 2018** for about five months, weather and maritime conditions permitting. All efforts will be made to reopen the wharf as soon as possible.

The NSW Government is upgrading Rydalmere Wharf as part of the Transport Access Program – an initiative to deliver modern, safe and

accessible transport infrastructure across the state. The upgraded wharf design was developed following feedback from the community and aims to balance safety, accessibility, efficient ferry operations and, environmental and heritage impacts.

Rydalmere Wharf will be closed during the wharf upgrade, from **Wednesday 3 October** for about five months.




Customers will be able to catch a temporary bus service, route 535, to Sydney Olympic Park Wharf, which will connect with F3 Parramatta River ferry services. The temporary bus service will operate between Parramatta Wharf and Sydney Olympic Park Wharf via South Street Rydalmere. Customers travelling to or from the city can also catch the existing bus service, route M52 from Victoria Road to Circular Quay.

Parramatta Wharf will remain open while planning for the Parramatta Wharf upgrade continues. Ferry services will continue to operate to Parramatta until planning is finalised and the Parramatta Wharf closes for construction. The Parramatta Wharf upgrade is expected to start before the end of 2018 and customers will be advised before the temporary closure of the wharf and start of work.
