Detour for night works on the Mitchell Highway at East Guyong from 30 March to 2 April

The NSW Government is funding safety upgrades work on the Mitchell Highway at East Guyong between Bathurst and Orange.

Transport for NSW will be removing temporary safety barriers and line marking.

A map is included to show the location of the work, and the location of the detour.

The scheduled work is expected to take three nights to complete between **Wednesday 30 March** and **Saturday 2 April**, weather permitting.

Work hours will be between **7pm** and **5am** from **Wednesday to Friday**. Notice will be provided if works extend outside the planned period.

How will the work affect you?

For the safety of motorists and our workers, work will be taking place at night. The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

During work hours, all traffic will be diverted on the Mid-Western Highway via Blayney. Motorists are advised to allow an additional 15 minutes to travel time.

Access will be maintained for residents and emergency services in the event of an emergency.
