

## Safety works Mitchell Highway Vittoria East from 27 April

The NSW Government is funding safety upgrades on the Mitchell Highway at Vittoria East as part of the Saving Lives on Country Roads program of works.

Transport for NSW will carry out the work which includes the construction of a site compound, drainage upgrades and road widening. We have included a map to show the location of the project.

With tree clearing completed earlier in the year, there will be ongoing early work activity from **7am to 5pm Monday to Friday** from **April 27** and is expected to take eight weeks to complete. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

### How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise. Access for property owners and emergency vehicles will be maintained.

### Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours. Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.

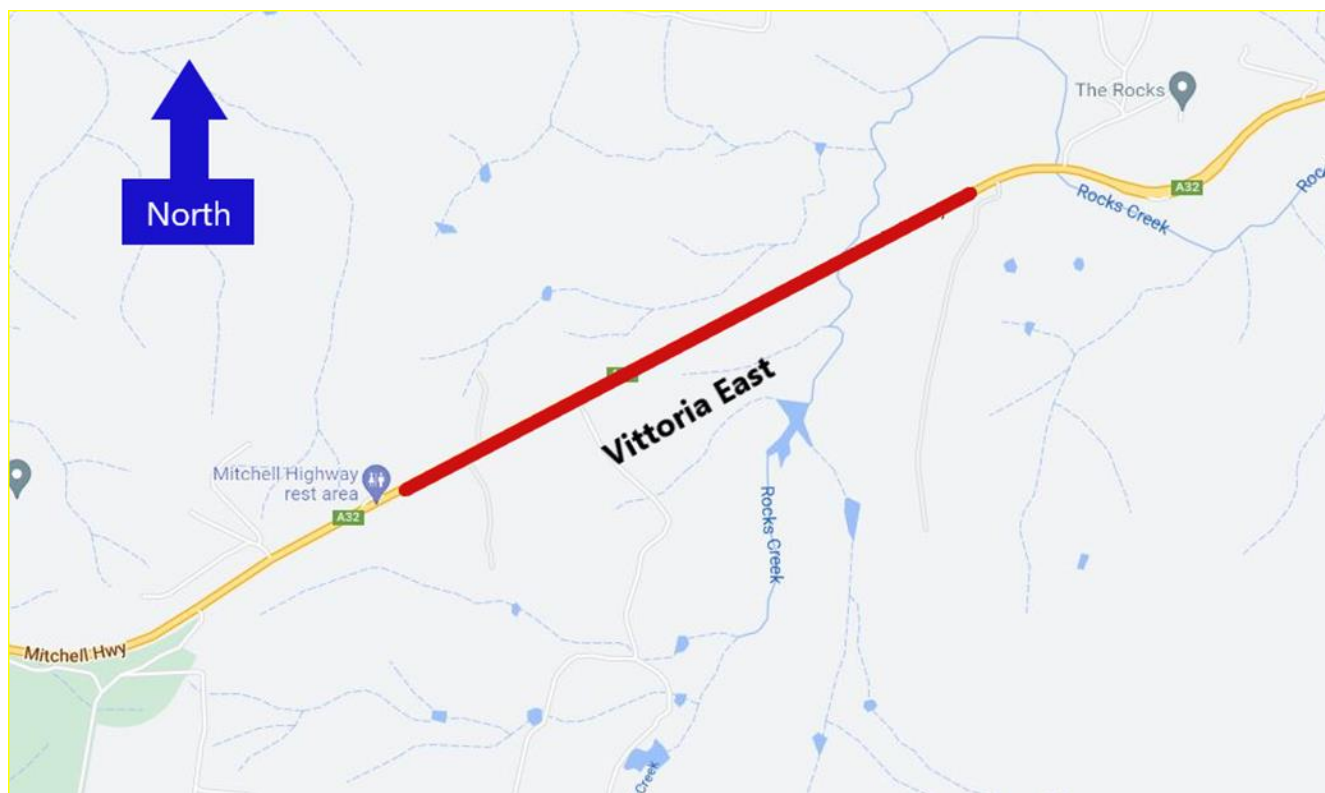
