Changed traffic conditions on the Mitchell Highway at Vittoria

The NSW Government is funding important safety work on the Mitchell Highway to provide a stronger, longer lasting and safer road as part of the Vittoria East project.

Transport for NSW will carry out temporary linemarking on Friday 18 November. We have included a map to show the location of the project.

We will be working between **7am** and **5pm** from **Friday 18 November** and expect to complete the work in one day, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise.

Traffic changes

The works will temporarily shorten an overtaking lane for the duration of the project. The overtaking lane will be reinstated at the conclusion of the upgrade.

Traffic control and reduced speed limits will also be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow extra travel time during this work.
