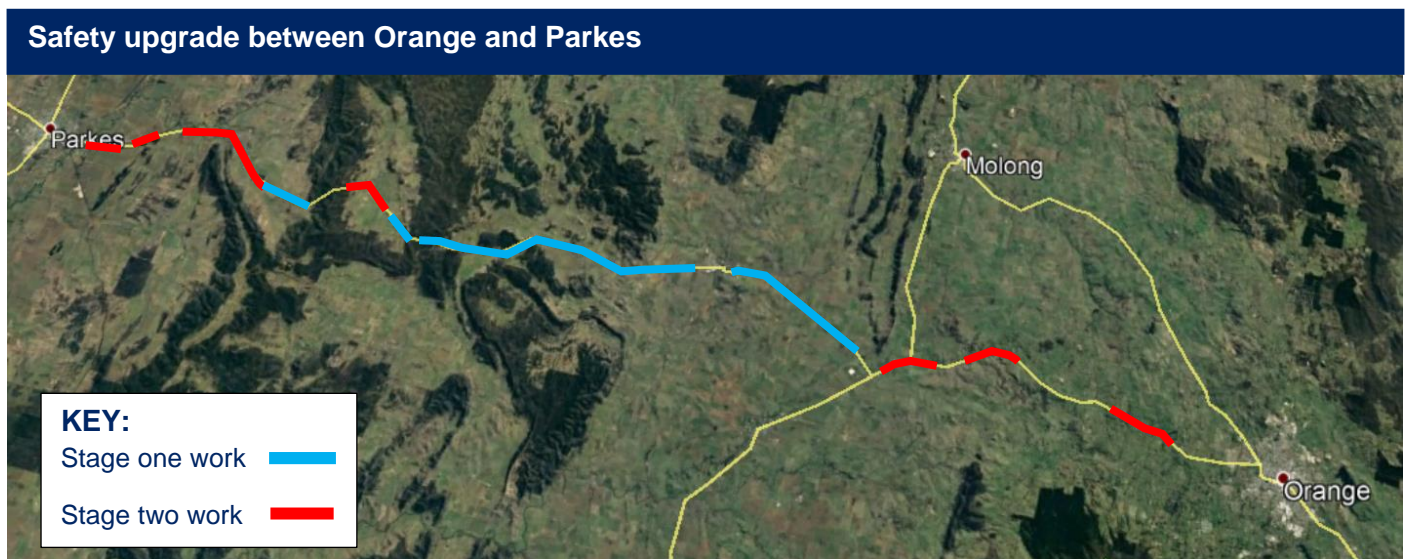


## Work continues on The Escort Way and Henry Parkes Way between Orange and Parkes

The NSW Government is funding \$12 million for safety upgrades along the 96 kilometre section of road between Orange and Parkes over the next two years.



Cabonne Council and Parkes Shire Council are carrying out the work, on behalf of Transport for NSW.

Vegetation removal has been completed with shoulder widening, safety barrier installation and intersection upgrades continuing along various sections of The Escort Way and Henry Parkes Way.

There are 10 projects as part of the safety upgrades and the work will be carried out in two stages. The first three projects to be carried out by Cabonne Council are Monument, 32 kilometres west of Orange, Red Hill, two kilometres west of Manildra and Cabonne Boundary, 14 kilometres west of Manildra.

Parkes Shire Council will carry out Bumberry Hills, 19 kilometres west of Manildra and Fairview, 32 kilometres west of Manildra as part of stage one.

We will provide another notification ahead of stage two commencing.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** Monday to Friday and between **8am** and **1pm** on Saturday and expect to complete stage one in **December**, weather permitting.

We will be working in more than one location at the same time to complete the five projects being delivered in stage one. The sections that are being carried out as stage one and stage two are highlighted in the map above.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

## How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations along the project length, and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Should your property access be affected we will contact you individually and traffic control will be on site to assist.

## Traffic changes

There may be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.
