South Mosman Wharf Upgrade

The NSW Government is proposing to upgrade South Mosman Wharf as part of the Transport Access Program.

Transport for NSW is improving Sydney's ferry services for customers. New and upgraded wharves are being delivered as part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program.

This program aims to ensure wharves provide customers with public transport that all members of the community can access.

Transport for NSW has also recently delivered upgraded wharves at Woolwich, Parramatta and Rydalmere.

Customers with mobility needs are currently unable to access Musgrave Street from South Mosman Wharf.

Following feedback from the community in May 2020, the Review of Environmental Factors for the proposed accessibility upgrade has been prepared and is on display for community feedback until **Friday 15 January 2021**.

The new South Mosman Wharf

The new wharf would provide South Mosman with facilities that all members of the community can access.

The proposal includes a floating pontoon with a covered waiting area, customer seating, weather protection and a covered gangway and jetty. A new lift and stairs would be installed providing an accessible route from street-level to the wharf.

New bicycle hoops would also be provided.

In response to community feedback the proposal now provides cover to the gangway, stairs and upper and lower platforms of the lift.

Since our community consultation in May 2020, we have changed the proposal so that the wharf structure is located further south improving safety in the Musgrave Street cul-de-sac.

Review of Environmental Factors

The Review of Environmental Factors (REF) is a planning document outlining the proposed work, potential impacts and mitigation measures.

The document includes assessments of the existing environment and expected impacts of the project on traffic and transport, flora and fauna, aquatic ecology, visual impact, noise and vibration, and heritage.

Potential construction impacts

Construction of the proposal would take up to six months to complete, weather and maritime conditions permitting.

It is expected that:

- temporary changes to pedestrian movements would be put in place during construction
- a number of trees along the lower foreshore would be replaced to allow for the new stairs and lift
- a small temporary construction compound would be established on land near the wharf

- some work to connect to local power supply including footpath excavation
- some truck movements would be required for landside work
- the Musgrave Street cul-de-sac would be temporarily closed to buses only
- there would be some truck movements on Musgrave Street.

We would notify the community before starting work.

Closure of the wharf and alternative transport during construction

South Mosman Wharf would be closed for up to six months during construction.

Alternative transport options for customers include the 236 bus service operating between Musgrave Street and Military Road/Spit Road, where they can connect with city and other services. Other public transport options include ferries at Mosman Bay Wharf.

The temporary closure of South Mosman Wharf would not change the timetable for ferry services to other wharves on the F6 route.

Customers would be encouraged to plan their trip by visiting transportnsw.info or call Transport Info on **131 500** before starting their journey.

Work hours and potential noise impacts


Our standard work hours would be between **7am** and **6pm Monday to Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturdays**. Some of the work during these times would be noisy. No work is planned for Sundays or public holidays.

Some out of hours work may be carried out for work that requires calm water conditions. We would notify impacted residents before carrying out any out of hours work.

We will consider all feedback received during the public display and prepare a submissions report that summarises the issues raised and our responses. This report will be made available on our website.

REF determination and detailed design will be carried out during the first half of 2021 with construction expected to start in late 2021.
