

# Improvements to Stacey Street and Fairford Road, Bankstown

## Start of work

Roads and Maritime Services | November 2019



Intersection improvements to Stacey Street and Fairford Road, Bankstown will improve traffic flow in peak periods.

The NSW Government is investing more than \$30 million to upgrade Stacey Street and Fairford Road in Bankstown.

Since Roads and Maritime completed the first stage of improvements on Stacey Street in April 2019, motorists have enjoyed improved traffic flow as a result of an additional southbound lane between Stanley Street and Macauley Avenue. They have also benefited from the extended double right turn bay at the intersection of Macauley Avenue.

On Monday 25 November, construction work will continue on the second and final stage of this project. We will be widening Stacey Street, northbound to provide an additional lane between Macauley Avenue and Stanley Street and upgrading the key intersections of Macauley Avenue and Stanley Street. More details are overleaf.

### Key benefits

- Reduced congestion on one of Sydney's key arterial roads by providing additional north and southbound lanes on Stacey Street, increasing space on the road to allow more motorists to use the corridor
- Easier access into and out of Macauley Avenue for road users by providing dual right turning lanes and a dedicated bus lane onto Fairford Road
- Improved traffic flow into Stanley Street from Stacey Street by allowing more vehicles to queue in the extended right turning bay
- Improved safety for pedestrians when crossing Salvia Avenue with the installation of new pedestrian crossing lights and pram facilities
- Improved travel time, journey reliability, and safety for all road users

## Stage 2 work on Stacey Street and Fairford Road, Bankstown



### Upcoming work includes

- adding new guard rails on Stacey Street northbound, between Macauley Avenue and Stanley Street
- changing Macauley Avenue to include double right turning lanes onto Fairford Road and a dedicated right turn lane for buses
- installing a new lane on Fairford Road
- installing a dedicated left turn lane at the Fairford Road/Macauley Avenue intersection
- installing a new pedestrian crossing at Salvia Avenue, near Stacey Street
- moving the pedestrian crossing across Stacey Street to the other side of Macauley Avenue
- adding a new third northbound lane on Stacey Street

- extending the right turn bay on Stacey Street southbound into Stanley Street
- removing the closed footbridge over the storm water drain on Stacey Street directly opposite Petunia Avenue

### Our work schedule

We will be on site **weekdays and Saturdays from 25 November until the project is completed**, weather permitting. This includes 40 night time shifts between December and February 2020. Specific details about night shifts will be communicated to specific residents when the shifts are rostered. Our day shift hours are from **Monday to Friday, between 7am and 6pm and between 8am and 1pm on Saturday**, and our night shift hours are from **Sunday to Thursday, between 8pm and 5am**. Work will stop over the holiday period between 21 December 2019 and 9 January 2020.

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier activities such as concrete cutting, chainsawing and jack hammering before midnight.

### Changes to traffic conditions

## Nearby projects

Roads and Maritime are planning an upgrade to a 2.2 kilometre section of Stacey Street and the Hume Highway in Bankstown, with the aim of reducing congestion and improving safety in the area. The proposed upgrade will involve widening Stacey Street to create a divided six lane road. Key intersections will also be upgraded and new shared pathways will be developed.

We are completing investigations to input the design of the new road including where it should be widened. Once further details on the project are known, the community will have the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback on the proposed design.
