Work is complete at Stoney Creek Road and Kingsgrove Road, Kingsgrove

End of work | March 2021

Transport for NSW has recently completed improvements to the intersection of Stoney Creek Road and Kingsgrove Road, Kingsgrove.

This project was funded under the NSW Government's Bus Priority Infrastructure Program, which aims to improve the reliability and efficiency of bus services, while easing congestion for all road users.

Work commenced in November 2020 and involved constructing a new dedicated left turn lane on Stoney Creek Road into Kingsgrove Road. A large part of the work was the relocation of gas, water, telecommunications, and electrical utilities.

We constructed new kerbs, gutters and footpaths, and completed resurfacing and new line marking on both Stoney Creek Road and Kingsgrove Road. We also upgraded the pedestrian crossings at the intersection to make them safer for all users.

We will work to complete the landscaping inside Kingsgrove High School. This work will continue until mid-April 2021.

Project benefits

- Improve traffic flow at the intersection
- Improve road safety and help reduce the number of crashes at the intersection
- Ease congestion and improve travel time reliability


We also had the pleasure of working with the school to select and plant new trees and shrubs on the front of the school grounds facing both Kingsgrove Road and Stoney Creek Road.


