

Bus stop changes in San Souci and Ramsgate



Transport for NSW is removing three bus stops and upgrading six bus stops on Rocky Point Road. These changes will take effect from March 21, 2022.

In 2021, Transport engaged with the local community about these changes, working to improve bus reliability and on-time running in San Souci and Ramsgate. The finalised bus stop changes reach a balance between maintaining a reasonable walking distance to bus stops and an efficient bus network. You can see the changes overleaf.

Transport will also make accessibility upgrades to bus stops. Making adjustments to the number of bus stops along a bus corridor also helps improve bus travel times. Each bus stop location is considered with a focus on the safety of bus customers and motorists.

The NSW Government has funded the Gateway to the South bus improvements program to improve the reliability of bus services on southern Sydney's main bus corridors.



Rocky Point Road near Newcombe Street and Bonanza Parade - remove two bus stops



The bus stop changes on both sides of Rocky Point Point Road near Newcombe Street include:

- removal of the northbound bus stop ID 221929 near Newcombe Street
- removal of the southbound bus stop ID 221978 between Sandringham Street and Bonanza Parade
- upgrading the adjacent 4 bus stops to comply with accessibility standards
- at removed bus zones, 'no stopping' will be implemented

Rocky Point Road before Park Road - remove one bus stop



B2 Ramsgate

The bus stop changes on Rocky Point Road include:

- removal of the southbound bus stop ID 2217123 before Park Road
- upgrading adjacent bus stops ID 2217122 and 221977 to comply with accessibility standards
- at removed bus zones, no stopping will be implemented



Transport will be upgrading the adjacent bus stops that bus customers will use as a result of the removal/relocation of bus stops. The bus stop upgrades will be carried out to comply with accessibility standards in accordance with the *Disability Standards* for Accessible Public Transport 2002.
