

# Airport precinct upgrade – Weekly update

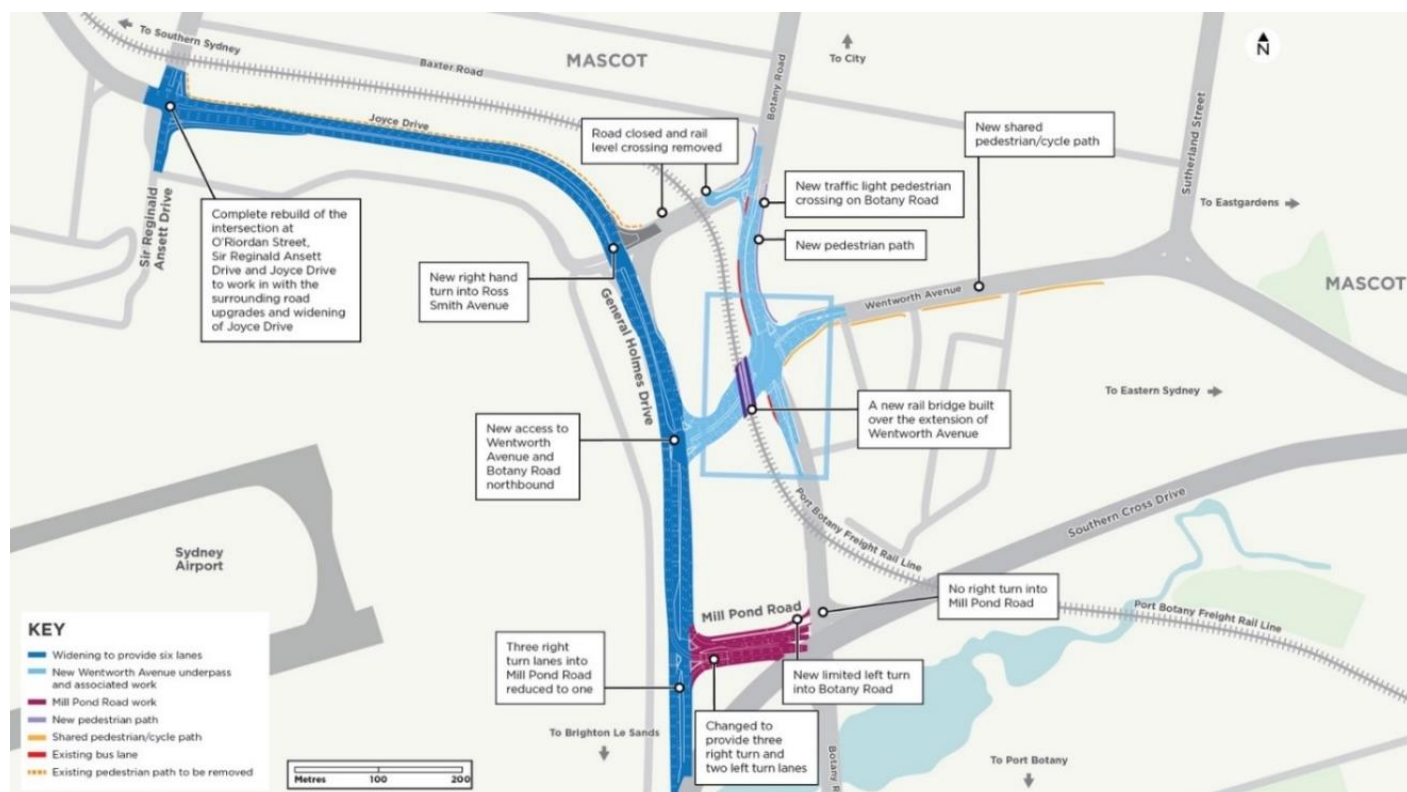
Week commencing Sunday 3 February 2019

## Airport East project work includes:

- service identification and relocation along Joyce Drive and General Holmes Drive
- road work, including asphaltting, line marking, installing traffic lights and barriers on General Holmes Drive
- identifying underground utility locations and pavement investigations along Botany Road, Botany Lane, Bronti Street, Mill Pond Drive, Wentworth Avenue, Hardie Street, Beresford Street, General Holmes Drive and Joyce Drive
- construction at the intersection of Botany Road and Wentworth Avenue, including the installation of traffic light cables and drainage
- construction inside the site compound on Wentworth Avenue and along the work area on Botany Road and Wentworth Avenue, including trenching and excavation
- major road work at the Botany Road and Wentworth Avenue intersection from 8pm Friday 8 February to 5am Monday 11 February, avoid non-essential travel in the area, traffic detours in place. See January notification for further detail
- kerb and footpath work along Botany Road, near Bronti Street. A pedestrian detour is in place for this work
- service relocation along Botany Road, Wentworth Avenue and Bronti Street
- construction, including piling and excavation at the new rail bridge location near Botany Road
- use of the storage site in Dransfield Avenue
- construction, including access, spoil and vegetation removal from Mill Pond Drive
- road work, including signal trenching on Mill Pond Drive
- operating and monitoring groundwater systems 24/7
- delivery of construction vehicles and equipment to the work areas

Standard construction hours for the **Airport East project** are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturday**, excluding public holidays. Out of hours work will include up to **five-night shifts** during the week and extended hours on Saturday. Our night working hours are **9pm to 5am**. Not all work during this time will be noisy.

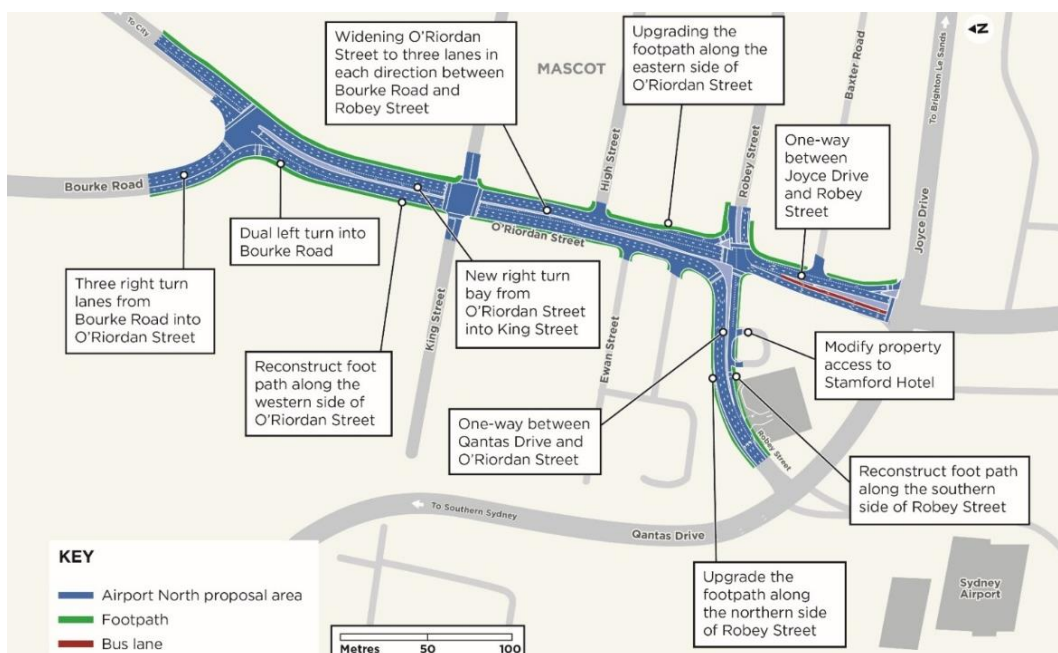


## Airport North project work includes:

- traffic management and roadwork, including line marking and line removal, sign and traffic barrier installation and temporary traffic changes along O’Riordan Street between Bourke Road and Joyce Drive
- the pedestrian footpath is closed on the eastern side of O’Riordan Street between High Street and Robey Street. Pedestrian detours are in place
- service identification on O’Riordan Street, Bourke Road, High Street, King Street, Robey Street and Baxter Road. This involves the use of a vacuum truck to safely identify the locations of the underground services
- service relocation including excavation and trenching across and along O’Riordan Street near Bourke Road, King Street and High Street
- traffic light adjustment, signage and barrier installation along O’Riordan Street near King Street and High Street
- service relocation and investigation, including excavation, trenching and stormwater work on Robey Street and Baxter Road
- reducing O’Riordan Street southbound between High Street and Joyce Drive from three lanes to two lanes to allow for roadwork. Please follow the directional signage and obey road work speed limits.
- ongoing pedestrian changes and detours during construction, please follow direction of signage
- removal of tree stumps and topsoil, including excavation and material removal in work areas along O’Riordan Street
- installation of environmental controls
- use of site compounds at 166 and 200 O’Riordan Street for delivery and removal of equipment and materials
- delivery of construction vehicles and equipment to the work areas.

Standard construction hours for the **Airport North project** are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturday**, excluding public holidays. Out of hours work will include up to **five-night shifts** during the week, our night working hours are **9pm to 5am**. Not all work during this time will be noisy.

Machinery and equipment used may include trucks, excavators, paving machines, rollers, lighting towers, road saws, plate compactors, vacuum trucks, grinders, cranes, elevated work platforms, chainsaws, mulching machines, light vehicles, hand tools, concrete trucks and equipment.
