Investigation work on Botany Road, Joyce Drive and General Holmes Drive, Mascot from Monday 25 May

The Australian and NSW governments are funding the Airport East precinct – Westconnex enabling works.

The aim of this project is to upgrade the roads east of Sydney's Kingsford Smith Airport and to remove the rail level crossing at General Holmes Drive. To inform the detailed design for the project, we will be carrying out field investigation work along Botany Road, Joyce Drive and General Holmes Drive.

Roads and Maritime will carry out survey and field investigation work, which includes locating underground services, surveying, geotechnical bore holes and test pits along Botany Road, Joyce Drive and General Holmes Drive.

This work will be carried out between **7am and 6pm** from **Monday 25 May to Friday 19 June** excluding Friday nights and weekends, weather permitting. During the same time, there will be 11 shifts of night work between **9pm and 5am.**

Where access to a property is needed, we will contact the residents and businesses and liaise directly with them.

Changed traffic conditions

Lane closures will be in place while work is carried out to ensure the safety of workers, Road users are asked to follow the direction of traffic controllers, adhere to reduced speed limits and follow traffic signs. Motorists may experience delays due to these changed traffic conditions.

There may be some noise associated with this work but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents and businesses.
