Continued work on the Port Botany freight rail line, Mascot

The Australian and NSW governments are upgrading roads in the Sydney Airport East precinct to improve traffic flow and access to the airport and Port Botany.

Roads and Maritime Services is delivering the Airport East precinct project, which includes upgrading General Holmes Drive between Mill Pond Road and Botany Road, Wentworth Avenue, Joyce Drive and Mill Pond Road, Mascot.

The Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) is working on the temporary rail deviation next to the existing freight rail line near Wentworth Avenue. The deviation will allow trains to continue to run while Roads and Maritime builds a new rail bridge over Wentworth Avenue.

To ensure that freight trains can transfer to the new track as scheduled, ARTC will need to work some additional night shifts in August.

There will be three shifts of night work scheduled between **Tuesday 16 August** and **Thursday 18 August** and one shift on **Friday 26 August**, weather permitting. Working hours will be from **10pm to 7am**.

Normal working hours will still be from **7am to 6pm on weekdays** and from **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**, weather permitting.

Work schedule over the weekend of 27 and 28 August

Further ARTC work on the new deviation will occur over the weekend of **27 and 28 August**.

Trains will start using the temporary freight rail deviation from **Monday 29 August**. The preparatory work and transfer to the temporary line must occur during this weekend, which is one of only four ARTC scheduled opportunities each year when the freight line will be closed.

Work will start from **7am Saturday 27 August** and continue through to **7am Monday 29 August**.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise during this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise, including ensuring our work program allows opportunities for respite.

No lane closures will be required, as work will be carried out within the rail corridor. There will be some minor impacts to traffic from truck movements into and out of the site.
