

Airport North Precinct Upgrade - temporary traffic changes in Mascot

The NSW Government is upgrading roads north of Sydney's Kingsford Smith Airport to improve traffic flow and connections to and from the Airport and Port Botany.

Transport for NSW are continuing to deliver this important project. During June and July 2020, there will be a number of temporary traffic changes, including some weekend closures. At times during the weekend closures traffic access to side roads and properties will be blocked.

These temporary traffic changes will allow larger sections of asphalt work to be completed on the western side of O'Riordan Street so work on this project can move forward.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise, light and vibration associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise the impact by using noise mats and directing lighting towers away from properties.

Traffic changes

- **7pm Friday 26 June to 5am Monday 29 June:** Stage 1 **access blocked to Sarah Street please use Ewan Street** to access all businesses and property on Sarah Street, Duguid Street and Coleman Street.
- **7pm Friday 3 July to 5am Monday 6 July:** Stage 2 **access blocked to Ewan Street please use Sarah Street** to access all businesses and property on Ewan Street, Duguid Street and Coleman Street.
- **7pm Friday 10 July to 5am Monday 13 July:** Stage 3 will be **working between Ewan Street and King Street**.
- **7pm Friday 17 July to 5am Monday 20 July:** Stage 4 will be **working between King Street and Bourke Road**. Access will be maintained to King Street west.
- **7pm Friday 24 July to 5am Monday 27 July:** Stage 5 will be **working between King Street and Bourke Road**.

The map provided shows the traffic arrangement during the weekend closure.



Please note: Some stages overlap, requiring multiple weekend closures to complete asphalt work.
